Paintball is a game in which players compete, in teams or individually, to eliminate opponents by hitting them with capsules containing paint from a special device called a paintball marker. Rules for playing paintball vary, but can include capture the flag, elimination, defending or attacking a particular point or area, or capturing objects of interest hidden in the playing area.

Do you provide instruction and equipment?
